

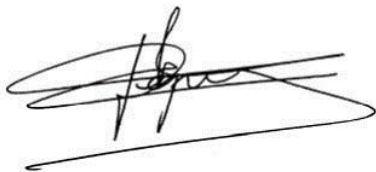
Subject: Volatile Organic Compounds (VoC)
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The European Directive 2004/42/CE on the limitation of emissions of volatile organic compounds due to the use of organic solvents in certain paints and varnishes and vehicle refinishing products defines 'Volatile organic compound (VOC)' as any organic compound having an initial boiling point less than or equal to 250°C measured at a standard pressure of 101.3 kPa.

This is to confirm that no organic solvents are used during the synthesis of the resins, nor during the production of Xeikon toners (QA-P, QA-CD, QB-I, QB-IC, QB-CH, QA-SR, QBE, QB-T and SPOT colours).

Xeikon toners are therefore completely free of VoC.

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
